Reservation fee and the first night are non-refundable. Also, there is a two-night non-refundable minimum at OB Fuller Park on any holiday weekend and at Pioneer during fair week. Campsite fees allow for two registered vehicles overnight. Any needed extra vehicle permits for overnight or visitors will be purchased on arrival. Tents may use electric sites at either park at the appropriate rate. Parks cannot guarantee particular sites or adjoining sites. To use air conditioning it is recommended to use 50-amp site. Cable television is included on electrical sites at Pioneer Trail Park.
